General Rules and Regulations

1. Management, the Committee, and/or Swan Lake Stables will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
 2. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change an obstacle or alter any course.
 3. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Harness is required when jumping for all competitors.
 4. Riders Must Show in a minimum of 3 shows and be present at the September 1 Finals to qualify for series end awards.
 5. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2009.
 6. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
 7. NO person will be allowed in the ring at any time unless invited in by the management.

 10. **Every horse on grounds must be entered** whether showing or not and pay the Non-Show Fee of \$35.00/per horse. Anyone not entered and caught on the grounds will be charged \$150.00/per horse facility use charge.

Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.

From Harrisburg traveling on Route 15 South - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Left off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. **Stay left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall)**. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.
