Every horse on grounds must be entered in the office whether showing or not and must present negative coggins. Any horse that is at the show but not entered in classes will be charged the Non-Show Fee of \$15.00/per horse in addition to the schooling fee if applicable.

General Rules and Regulations

1. Management, the Committee, and/or Swan Lake Stables will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
2. **Warning** - In accordance with PA Act #93 of 2005 you assume the risk of Equine Activities Pursuant to Pennsylvania Law.
3. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Harness is required when jumping for all competitors.
4. All exhibitors must appear in proper show attire.
5. The State of Pennsylvania requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months. Bring Coggins Certificate to the secretary.
6. **Every horse on grounds must be entered in the office** whether showing or not and must present negative coggins. Any horse that is at the show but not entered in classes will be charged the Non-Show Fee of \$15.00/per horse in addition to the schooling fee if applicable.
7. Please use designated parking areas. You will be asked to move your vehicle if
8. All Dogs must be on a leash when on the property.
9. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks first offence. \$100 dollars all concurrent offences

Class Conduct

1. Three entries unless otherwise noted are required to be a complete class. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change an obstacle or alter any course.
2. NO person will be allowed in the ring at any time unless invited in by the management.
3. Six Ribbons will be awarded in all classes, unless otherwise stated.
4. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions with 3 classes (must include an under saddle in the hunter divisions).

Series Conduct

1. We offer Champion and Reserve Champion Series Awards in every division
2. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of the first day of the schooling series and remains the same throughout.
3. Riders and horse must show in a minimum of three shows in their division and be present at the September Finale to qualify for series end awards.

Walk-Trot Hunter Division

Designed for beginning horses, ponies and/or riders. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability to rider and soundness. Martingales prohibited in all flat classes. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any classes jumping more than 4 fences.

3. Walk Hunter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
4. Walk-Trot Hunter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
5. Walk-Trot Hunter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.

Walk-Trot-Canter Hunter Division

Designed for beginning horses, ponies and/or riders. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability to rider and soundness. Martingales prohibited in all flat classes. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any classes jumping more than 4 fences.

Open to riders **12 years of age and under**. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider 50% and equitation of rider 50%.

All Hunter Derbies open to horses and ponies. Distances will not be adjusted. These classes will be run as a two round competition with numerical scoring. The top twelve (12) horses to return for the second round.

If there are less than 6 entries in any height section the sections will be combined. If two sections are combined, the combined class will run for \$500. If all three sections are combined the class will run for \$750. Class Entry Fee: \$50

From Frederick traveling on Route 15 North - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Right off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. **Turn left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall)**. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.

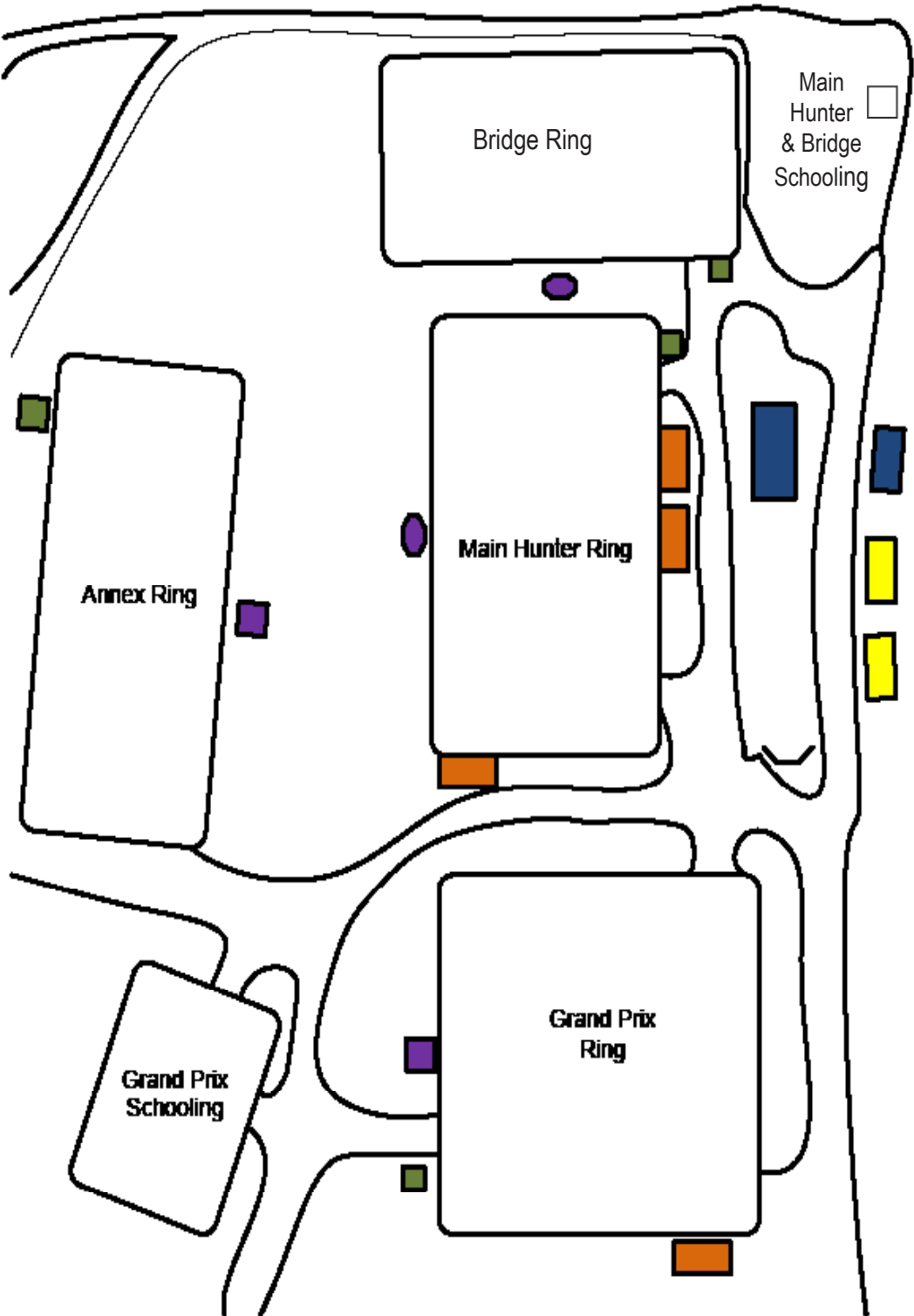
From Harrisburg traveling on Route 15 South - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Left off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. **Turn left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall)**. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.

From Westminster traveling on Route 97 North - Past McDonalds in Littlestown. Right onto Whitehall Rd. 1 mile, turn right onto Littlestown Road. Go past Kosmos Farm, left onto Flatbush Road. Farm 1 mile on right.

From Hanover traveling on Rt. 116 towards Gettysburg - Take a left on Littlestown Road. Go approximately 2.5 miles (Past the Flatbush Golf Course) and take a right on Flatbush Road. Swan Lake is 1/2 mile on your right.
