USHJA STIRRUP CUP CHAMPIONSHIP

A Stirrup Cup Championship is designed to reward participants in the USHJA Stirrup Cup Award Program by providing them with the opportunity to earn Championship Points.

- USHJA Zone Stirrup Cup Championships are held at a USEF Licensed Jumper Level 1 or 2 and/or a Regional I or Regional II Rated Hunter competition in a given Zone based upon the recommendation of the applicable Zone Committee and Working Group and subject to the approval of the Executive Director.
- USHJA Zone Stirrup Cup Championships are open to competitors who meet the minimum eligibility requirements, unless a zone specifically creates qualifying criteria and provides it to USHJA.
- In order to earn Championship Points in Hunter and Jumper sections, the owner or recorded leasee of the horse/pony must reside within the Zone. Horse owner, rider and trainer must be Active/competing members of USEF and USHJA. Horses must have a USEF annual or Life recording and USHJA registration. In Equitation sections the rider must reside within the Zone to participate in the Stirrup Cup Championship and receive Championship Points.
- **The following sections must be offered:** Children's Hunter Horse, Children's Hunter Pony, Adult Amateur Hunter, Low Children's Hunter Horse Low Adult Amateur Hunter, Green 3' and 3'3", Low Amateur Owner 3'3", Low Junior Hunter 3'3", Low Pony Hunter, Equitation 17 & Under, Adult Equitation 18 & Over, Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper and 0.90m Children/Adult Amateur Jumper.
 - **Hunter and Equitation – Section Format:** must be offered with a minimum of two over fences classes and one under saddle class as defined in HU148. Management may designate the classes of the existing section that will count for the USHJA Stirrup Cup Championship Points. Additional classes are not required to be held for the USHJA Stirrup Cup Championship. Eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in each class will receive Stirrup Cup Championship Points. Stirrup Cup Championship Points will be awarded for Champion and Reserve Champion.
 - **Hunter – Classic Format:** may also be offered in a Classic format with two over fences rounds. If offered in this format then eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in the second round of the Hunter Classic will receive Stirrup Cup Championship Points.
 - **Jumper – Section Format:** may be offered as two or three individual classes. Management may designate the classes of the existing section that will count for the USHJA Stirrup Cup Championship Points. Additional classes are not required to be held for the USHJA Stirrup Cup Championship. Eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in each class will receive Stirrup Cup Championship Points.
 - **Jumper – Classic Format:** may also be offered in a two round/ one jump-off Classic format. If offered in this format then eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in the final overall placings of the Classic will receive Stirrup Cup Championship Points.
- **A minimum of 3 Zone Stirrup Cup Championship exhibitors from the zone must compete in order for the Stirrup Cup Championship Points to be awarded.** The definition of compete for Hunters and Age Group Equitation is in accordance with HU133 and the definition of compete for Jumpers is in accordance with JP135.13.
- If the competition charges exhibitors an additional fee ("Armband Fees") to compete in the Stirrup Cup Championship, a minimum of 3 Zone Stirrup Cup Championship exhibitors from the zone must pay the additional fee and compete in order for the Stirrup Cup Championship Points to be awarded.

HUNTERS/EQUITATION

Champion and Reserve Championship Points will be given to the Stirrup Cup Championship sections that follow HU148. Champions will receive 80 Championship Points for each section completed and Reserve Champions will receive 48 Championship Points.

JUMPERS

Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, Thoroughbred Jumpers and Low Pony Jumpers will receive points from the Stirrup Cup Championship Point Chart excluding Champion and Reserve points.

1.20/1.25 Junior Jumper, 1.20/1.25 Amateur Owner Jumper, and 1.20 Jumpers will be based on one point for every dollar won unless no money is awarded and then these classes will receive the points from the Stirrup Cup Championship Point Chart excluding Champion and Reserve points.

GENERAL INFORMATION

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

All dogs must be on leashes and under owners control.

All Hunter and Equitation classes will receive ribbons through eighth place. All sections with three or more classes will receive champion and reserve Awards. Jumper Awards follow USEF JP110.

Sharps and Medical waste must be disposed of in sharps container available in the barns.

ENTRIES

Entries received after the close of entries September 27, 2017 will be charged a \$25 post entry fee.

NO PHONE or FAXED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entry forms must be filled out **completely and legibly** including all classes and divisions entered, signatures, ID numbers, and organization or membership numbers before numbers will be issued. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and

those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms.

*AN OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD, VALID COGGINS TEST, PROOF OF EHV-1 VACINATION AND ALL APPLICABLE MEMBERSHIP AND MEASUREMENT CARDS ARE REQUIRED TO BE PRESENTED TO THE OFFICE **BEFORE** NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP.*

An office fee of \$25 will be assessed all entries. All accounts must be settled within 60 days of the end of the competition. A processing fee of \$100 plus collection fees will be charged for all non negotiable checks.

SCHOOLING RULES

Main Hunter Ring - Schooling in the morning until approx ½ hour prior to the start of the first class.

Bridge Ring - Schooling in the morning until approx ½ hour prior to the start of the first class.

Grand Prix Ring - Schooling on the Flat until approx ½ hour prior to the start of the first class.

STABLING

Stalls are both permanent and tent stalls with doors. Stalls are \$75 for the weekend, and are on a first come first served basis. All stall requests must be accompanied by the \$50 non-refundable stall fee and must be received the close of entries to guarantee that we will have your stalls for you. **STALLS RECEIVED WITHOUT A DEPOSIT WILL NOT BE RESERVED!**

Stalls that are scratched will be refunded less the deposit after the office fee is paid. Horses under the same ownership are able to share stalls. Horses staying in stalls will not be charged a grounds fee.

Hay and shavings are available for purchase.

No Electric Golf Carts. All extension cords used in the tents must be a minimum of #14.

CAMPER SPACES

Camper spaces must be reserved on your entry or with the office (717) 359-5357. All campers \$50 Camper Fee per weekend.

NON-SHOWING HORSES

Horses on the show grounds who are not entered in classes will be charged a \$15 non-showing horse fee and must be reported in the office and must present negative coggins and proof of EHV 1/4 within 6 months.

SCRATCHES

If you need to scratch, please do so by emailing us or by leaving a voicemail at 717-359-5357. Any entry not scratched before the start of entered classes will be responsible for the office fee and a \$15 scratch fee.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and

Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AWARDS & PRIZE MONEY

Eight ribbons, unless otherwise stated, will be presented in all classes. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions containing three or more classes with three or more competitors that run to completion. In the Hunter ring, this must include the Under Saddle class if applicable.

Prize money will be credited to your bill. Please designate the payee along with mailing address and tax id on the entry blank. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the competition.

Three entries, unless otherwise stated, are necessary to fill a class, or the class may be canceled.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DIRECTIONS TO SWAN LAKE

From Frederick on Route 15 traveling North - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Bear right off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. Take first Left on to White Hall Rd. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Junque Shop, take left onto Honda Road. Make immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Swan Lake is 3/4 mile on the left.

From Harrisburg on Route 15 traveling South - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Go left off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. Stay left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall). Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Make immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Swan Lake is 3/4 mile on left.

From Westminster on Route 97 North - Go past McDonald's in Littlestown and Turn right at the Royal Farms onto Whitehall Rd. Go 1 mile, turn right onto Littlestown Road. Take second left onto Flatbush Road. Swan Lake is 1 mile on right.

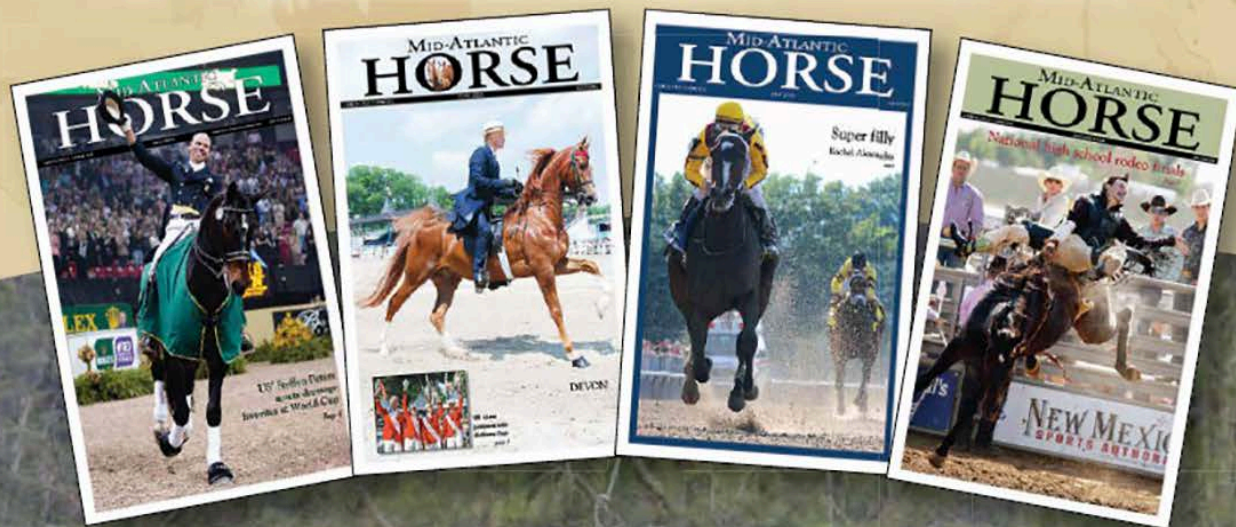
